The NIFT, Chennai Textile Design Sem VI student, Mr. Adheep A.K. was spotted by Laura. C. Wright, an American Textile artist when she was invited to the institute for a presentation on her smart textile project on 22nd Feb, 2018. He was invited as a representative of NIFT to Pepper house, Kochi, Kerala to participate in Zero 1 mission, a project aimed at depicting Gender equality through smart textile art installation. It consisted of a series of educational workshops with an exposure to sound based art practices organised by American Art Incubation India, an initiative of the Department of State, USA and ZERO1. It was held in partnership with Kochi Biennale Foundation (KBF), an international art forum held every two years and Sacred Heart College, Thevara.

There were totally 16 participants who were all well established art professionals were divided into 4 teams. He participated in the project for 5 days (2 weekends and a Wednesday between Feb 25th to March 4th) following which the teams were given two weeks(march 5th to 16th march) to develop their prototype based on their concept.

The team headed by Mr. Adeep named their project as "AXIA" Greek word meaning "Value". There was a distinguished Jury including Robert.G.Burgas (American Counsel General), Maya Sundararajan, regional Officer, United States India, Manju Sara Rajan (CEO Kochi Muziris Biennial foundation) evaluated their project. It was awarded 16 lakhs rupees to actualize it which would be showcased in the forthcoming Kochi Biennale. Mr. Adeep also topped all the 16 participants/art professionals and won a 15 days trip to USA and was also awarded a Fulbright scholarship for further studies.




AXIA

The project aims to conduct a survey to collect random samples of opinions from various genders, places and different age groups and visualise the collected data in an interesting way to show how it affects the stability of a society. The installation tries to prove that in a stable society there is always an equality among all the genders and everyone's voices are heard and considered.

FUTURE OF PROJECT

To take a bigger leap we would like to install the project at public spaces similar to how telephone booth are placed. So that if there is a call for gender equality issue people can talk in real time and convey their idea about the situation in such a way that the addressed issue is broadcasted anonymously in different public spaces. Hence we took these datas/conversations to levitate a globe, trying to imply that having a meaning full conversation can bring stability in the society.


